The children in the photographs are primarily those of farm workers. Most of the people were permanent residents of the Mt. Vernon area. Some of the children belonged to migrant farm workers, traveling from one crop to another.

The day of the photographs may well have been the fifth of May, Cinco de Mayo. Culturally relevant play taking place. In several of the frames the pinata, the painting of a hollow paper mache shaped doll of animal representation, is full of prizes is hanging from the ceiling.
